The organizers of the conference have the discretion to put your paper in an anthology or journal.

Presenters should register by 15th April 2015 to ensure inclusion of their papers in the conference program. No presenter will be allowed to present his/her paper if he/she has not registered for the conference. In case of any delay in registration you need to inform the organizers in good time. Participants will be entitled to the conference kit, teas and snacks and lunch. Accommodation is not provided. If the participants wish for an accommodation, the secretariat will be available for assistance. The list of nearby accommodations will be provided. The conference proceeding will be available in form of a books published by AFRICE and University of Nairobi. In the event that you decide to withdraw from the conference kindly inform the organizing committee/conference coordinator in good time.
