‘Madam Chancellor, in the 2019/2020 academic year the following..... (state the number) candidate(s), whom I have the honour to present to you, satisfied the board of examiners and Senate for the award of the degree of Doctor of Philosophy of the University of Nairobi’.

The Dean/Director will read the names of the Doctor of Philosophy candidate(s) who will stand and remain standing until the Chancellor reads the citation conferring the degree.

After presenting the PhD candidate(s), the Dean/Director will lift his/her cap, acknowledge the Chancellor and take his/her seat.

The Chancellor will confer the degree on the candidate(s) by saying;

‘I admit you to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy, and by my authority and that of the entire University, give power to read and to do all that appertains to this degree’.

The candidates shall bow/curtsy the Chancellor and resume their seats.

MASTERS, POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMAS, BACHELORS AND DIPLOMAS

The citation for all the Deans of Faculties/School/Institutes/Centres shall be as follows:

‘Madam Chancellor, in the 2019/2020 academic year the following candidates, whom I have the honour to present to you, satisfied the Board of Examiners and Senate for the following awards of the University of Nairobi’

MASTER OF.....

(The Dean/Director will read only one name for Masters degree candidates)

(The Dean/Director will then request the candidates to be seated by saying, *please be seated*)

POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN.....

(The Dean/Director will read only one name for postgraduate diploma candidates)

(The Dean/Director will then request the candidates to be seated by saying, ***please be seated***)

BACHELOR OF.....

The Dean/Director will indicate the classification of the degrees and the serial numbers of the names of candidates on the respective slides, and request the candidates to stand.

On completion, the Dean/Director will request the candidates to be seated by saying, ***please be seated***).

DIPLOMA IN

The Dean/Director will request the Diploma candidates to stand.

After a pause, the Dean/Director will request the candidates to be seated by saying, ***please be seated***)

The Dean/Director will then acknowledge the Chancellor by lifting his/her cap and bow/ curtsy to the Chancellor before resuming his/her seat.

When all the names of the graduands have been read out, the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic Affairs) will request all candidates for the award of Master degrees to stand up.

The Chancellor will thereafter confer the respective degrees by saying;

‘I admit you to the respective degrees for which you have been educated, trained, examined and qualified, and by my authority and that of the entire University, give power to read and to do all that appertains to these degrees’.

The candidates will then bow/curtsy and sit down.

Similarly, the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic Affairs) will request all candidates for the award of Bachelor degrees to stand up and the same procedure will be repeated.

After the conferment of the Bachelor degrees, the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic Affairs) will request all candidates for the award of Postgraduate Diplomas to stand up. The Chancellor will award the Postgraduate Diplomas by saying;-

‘I award you the respective Postgraduate Diplomas of the University of Nairobi’.

The candidates will bow/curtsy and sit down.

The same procedure will be followed in the case of Diploma candidates.
